Haven't got the patience to wait for the latest bestseller to arrive from Amazon.com? A bit nervous about purchasing pirated books from dodgy hawkers and DVD shops? Don't worry. There are plenty of bookstores in Shanghai selling the best and most recent authentic English-language books.

# 1. Shanghai Foreign Languages Bookstore

This bookstore boasts the largest collection of Englishlanguage books in the city.

It is also the best place to go if you have an interest in studying Chinese. On the first floor you can find various Chinese textbooks and dictionaries, along with a big selection of travel guides.

The fourth floor of the bookstore harbors a good selection of both popular and classic books in foreign languages, most of which are in English. The latest magazines and newspapers are also available.

# 2. Chaterhouse Booktrader

Located among high-end fashion boutiques, Chaterhouse is a quiet place ideal for perusing. It has a comprehensive collection of books, including fiction, non-fiction, travel, history, art, health, business, children's literature and magazines.

Chaterhouse displays the books alphabetically according to the surname of the author, which makes it very convenient to look for books.

If you can't find what you want, the bookstore lets you order from the world's biggest publishing houses, including Macmillan, HarperCollins, Random House and Penguin.

You can also find fine art postcards and many photographic and illustrated books on Shanghai, which make great gifts, keepsakes or souvenirs.

# 3. Garden Books

Located in a beautiful old villa with a garden, Garden Books is a wonderful place to shop for your favorite books. It also has an attached café (an adjunct very common in Western countries), where you can relax with a book while enjoying coffee, Italian ice cream or sandwiches.

This two-storey bookstore provides an extensive selection of English-language books for all ages. The children's section stocks thousands of books, while a play area with easels and colored pencils lets the kids get creative.

## 4. Old China Hand Reading Room (Hanyuan Shuwu)

The bookstore and quasi-library is located on charming Shaoxing Road in the former French Concession. The street is also home to several publishing houses.

Founded in 1996 by photographer Deke Erh and notable Shanghai historian Tess Johnston, the Old China Hand Reading Room has plenty of books about China, especially Chinese history.
