One of the must-know places in Shenzhen for foreigners is MixC — a premium shopping mall in the city center. It is one of the most luxurious shopping malls, selling clothes, cosmetics and fashion accessories. There is a large indoor ice-skating rink, a movie theater and a super market selling imported goods. You can also find quite a few foreign restaurant brands here, including Pizza Hut, Starbucks and a Japanese noodle house.
